# 74AUP1G96 TinyLogic<sup>®</sup> Low Power Universal Configurable Two-Input Logic Gate (Open Drain Output)

## Description

The 74AUP1G96 is a universal configurable. two-input logic gate with an open-drain output that provides a high-performance and low-power solution for battery-powered portable applications. This product is designed for a wide low voltage operating range (0.8 V to 3.6 V) and guarantees very low static and dynamic power consumption across the entire voltage range. All inputs are implemented with hysteresis to allow for slower transition input signals and better switching noise immunity.

The 74AUP1G96 provides for multiple functions as determined by various configurations of the three inputs. The potential logic functions provided are MUX, AND, OR, NAND, and, NOR inverter and buffer (see Figure 2 to Figure 8).

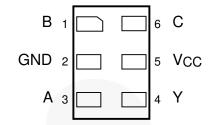


Figure 1. MicroPak™ (Top Through View)

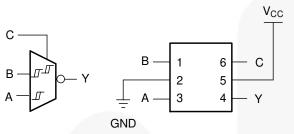

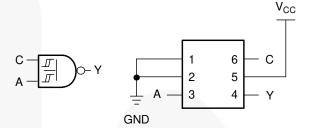

## **Logic Configurations**

Figure 2 through Figure 8 show the logical functions that can be implemented using the 74AUP1G98. The diagrams show the DeMorgan's equivalent logic duals given two-input function. The logical implementation is next to the board-level physical implementation of how the pins of the function should be connected.

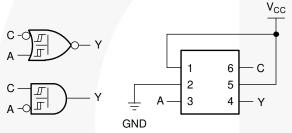


Figure 4. Input NOR Gate with One Inverted Input 2-Input AND Gate with One Inverted Input

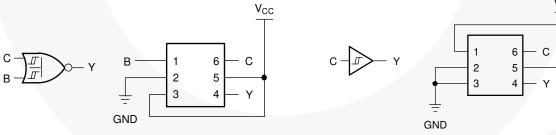


Figure 6. 2-Input NOR Gate

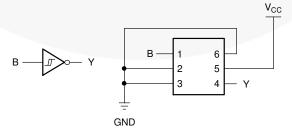


Figure 8. Inverter

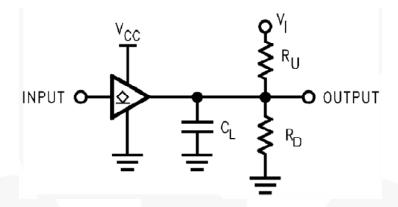

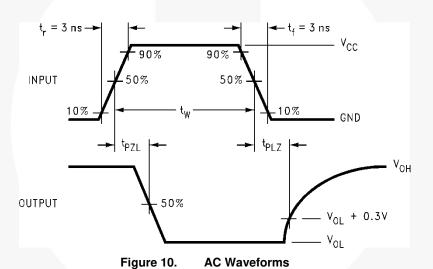

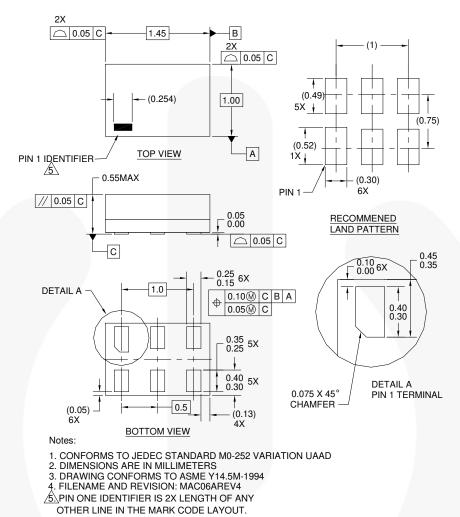


Figure 11. 6-Lead, MicroPak™, 1.0 mm Wide

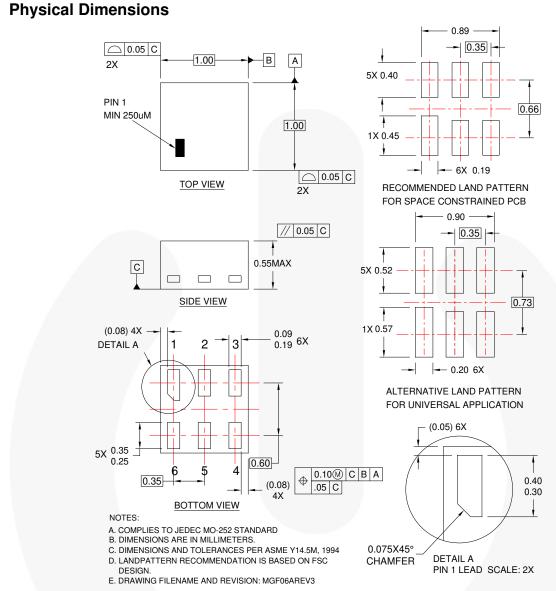


Figure 12. 6-Lead, MicroPak2™, 1x1 mm Body, .35 mm Pitch
