### 1. General description

The 74HC138-Q100; 74HCT138-Q100 decodes three binary weighted address inputs (A0, A1 and A2) to eight mutually exclusive outputs ( $\overline{Y}0$  to  $\overline{Y}7$ ). The device features three enable inputs ( $\overline{E}1$ ,  $\overline{E}2$  and  $\overline{E}3$ ). Every output will be HIGH unless  $\overline{E}1$  and  $\overline{E}2$  are LOW and E3 is HIGH. This multiple enable function allows easy parallel expansion to a 1-of-32 (5 to 32 lines) decoder with just four '138' ICs and one inverter. The '138' can be used as an eight output demultiplexer by using one of the active LOW enable inputs as the data input and the remaining enable inputs as strobes. Inputs include clamp diodes. This enables the use of current limiting resistors to interface inputs to voltages in excess of  $V_{CC}$ .

This product has been qualified to the Automotive Electronics Council (AEC) standard Q100 (Grade 1) and is suitable for use in automotive applications.









Fig 8. Test circuit for measuring switching times



Fig 9. Package outline SOT109-1 (SO16)






Fig 11. Package outline SOT763-1 (DHVQFN16)
