





Figure 3. Typical On-Resistance vs. Drain Current

Figure 5. Typical On-Resistance vs. Drain Current and Temperature










T_J, JUNCTION TEMPERATURE (*C*)
Figure 6. On-Resistance Variation with Temperature
















Figure 8. Gate Threshold Variation vs. Junction Temperature











Figure 13. Transient Thermal Resistance


