



Figure 1. Typical Output Characteristics




Figure 3. Typical Saturation Voltage Characteristics





Figure 5. Saturation Voltage vs. Case




Figure 4. Transfer Characteristics





Figure 6. Saturation Voltage vs. Vge

Figure 7. Saturation Voltage vs. V<sub>GE</sub>




Figure 9. Gate Charge Characteristics




Figure 11. Turn-On Characteristics vs.
Gate Resistance




Figure 8. Capacitance Characteristics




Figure 10. SOA Characteristics





Figure 12. Turn-Off Characteristics vs.

Figure 13. Turn-On Characteristics vs. Collector Current




Figure 14. Turn-off Characteristics vs. Collector Current




Figure 15. Switching Loss vs.

Gate resistance




Figure 16. Switching Loss vs. Collector Current




Figure 17. Turn-Off Switching SOA Characteristics Collector Currrent






Figure 18. Diode Forward Characteristics
