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

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




Fig.1 Relative Intensity vs. Wavelength


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
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### Typical Electrical / Optical Characteristics Curves




Fig.4 Relative Luminous Intensity vs. Forward Current




Fig.5-1 Spatial Distribution




Fig.5-3 Spatial Distribution




Fig.5-2 Spatial Distribution




Fig.5-4 Spatial Distribution

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
