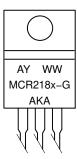

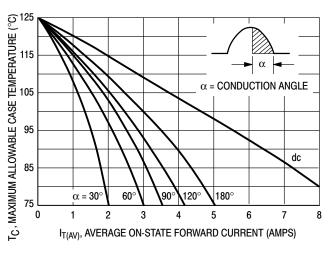

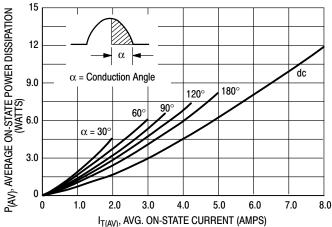
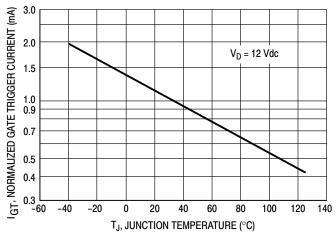


Figure 1. Current Derating

Figure 2. On-State Power Dissipation



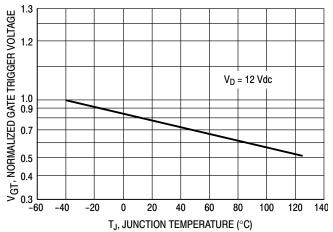


Figure 3. Typical Gate Trigger Current versus Temperature

Figure 4. Typical Gate Trigger Voltage versus Temperature

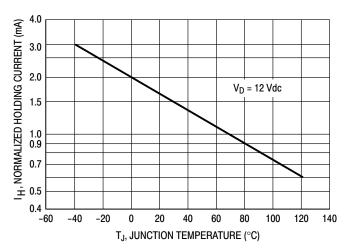
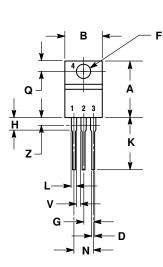
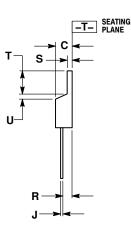


Figure 5. Typical Holding Current versus Temperature
