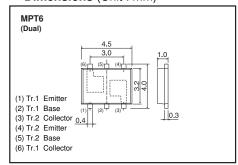

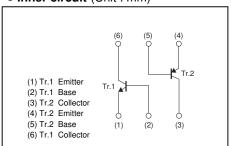

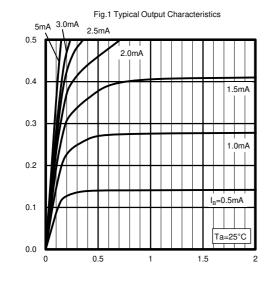

Fig3. DC Current Gain vs. Collector Current ( II )

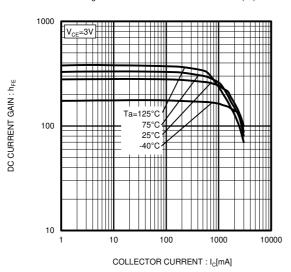


Fig.5 Collector-Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Collector Current ( II )

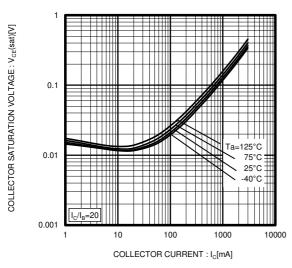


Fig.2 DC Current Gain vs. Collector Current ( I )

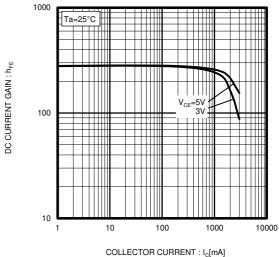


Fig.4 Collector-Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Collector Current ( I )

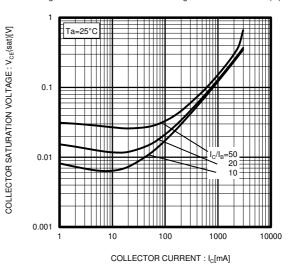


Fig.6 Ground Emitter Propagation Characteristics

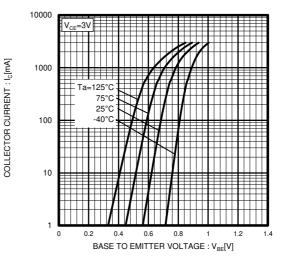


Fig.7 Emitter Input Capacitance vs. Emitter-Base Voltage Collector Output Capacitance vs. Collector-Base Voltage

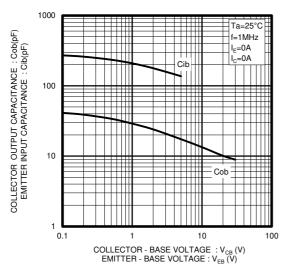


Fig.9 Safe Operating Area

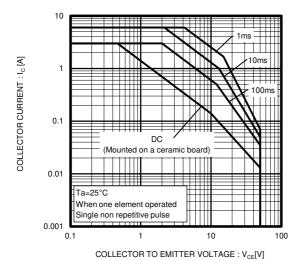
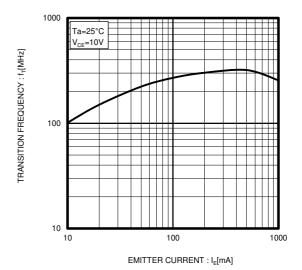
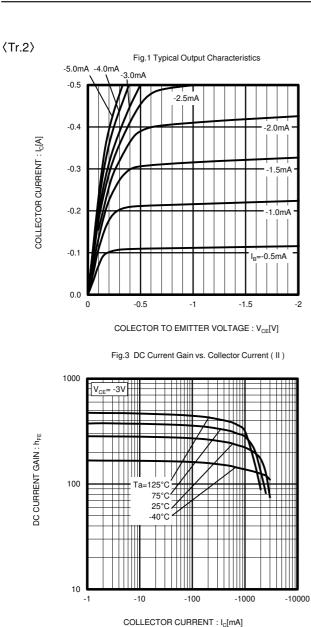
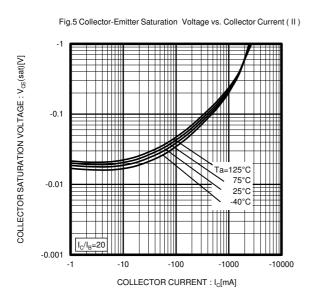
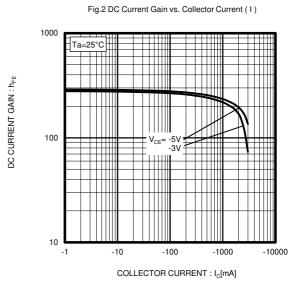


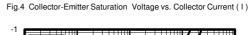
Fig.8 Gain BandwidthProduct vs. Emitter Current











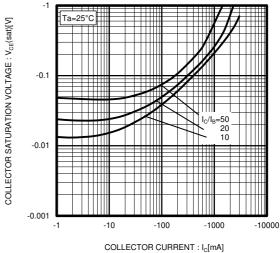


Fig.6 Ground Emitter Propagation Characteristics

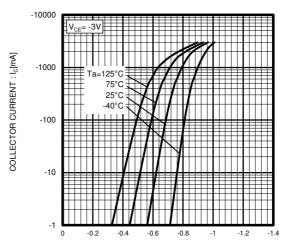


Fig.7 Emitter Input Capacitance vs. Emitter-Base Voltage Collector Output Capacitance vs. Collector-Base Voltage

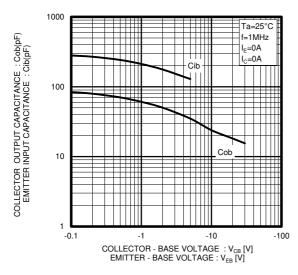


Fig.9 Safe Operating Area

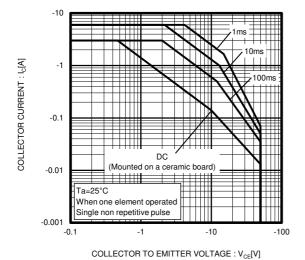
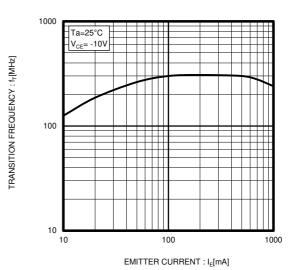
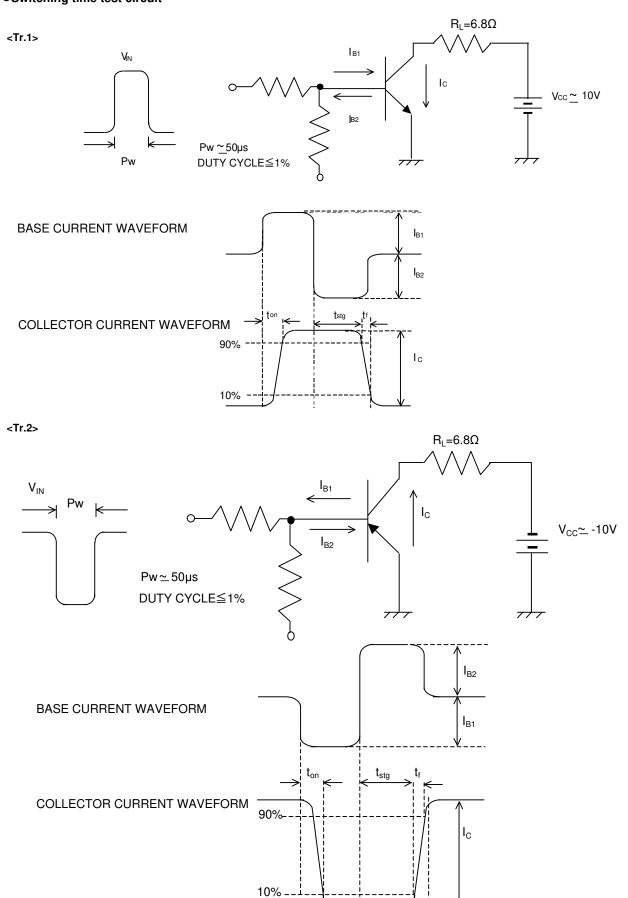


Fig.8 Gain Bandwidth Product vs. Emitter Current
