






Fig 3. DC current gain as a function of collector current; typical values

Fig 4. Collector current as a function of collector-emitter voltage; typical values




Fig 5. Base-emitter voltage as a function of collector current; typical values

Fig 6. Base-emitter saturation voltage as a function of collector current; typical values



Fig 7. Collector-emitter saturation voltage as a function of collector current; typical values




